



Privacy Policy

Green Power Investment Corporation (hereinafter, “the Company”) respects individual dignity and recognizes the importance of personal information. The Company will appropriately handle such information in compliance with the Act on the Protection of Personal Information (the “Personal Information Protection Law.”)

1. Compliance with Laws and Regulations

The Company will not only comply with the applicable laws and regulations, guidelines and other norms relating to the handling of personal information, but also continually review and update this Privacy Policy and its data management systems.

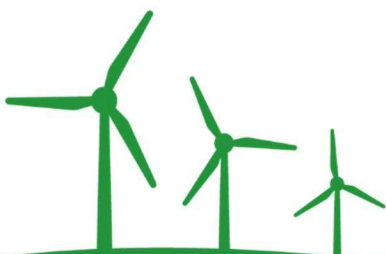
2. Purpose of Use

The Company will use the personal information obtained in the course of its business activities such as renewable energy projects (for more details, please refer to the Company’s website) only to the extent necessary for achieving the following purposes of use.

Unless required by law, the Company will not use personal information for any purpose other than those listed below without obtaining the individual’s consent.

- (1) Execution and management of contracts and related transactions
- (2) Proposals and related communications with landowners and clients and business partners
- (3) Communication and notifications to clients and business partners
- (4) Responding to inquiries and feedback
- (5) Business development, implementation, research, analysis, administration, and auditing activities
- (6) Information exchange with relevant industry stakeholders, public institutions, and academic organizations
- (7) Recruitment decisions, notifications, and post-hire HR management
- (8) Facilitating other operations related to the Company’s business

The Company will not change the intended purpose of personal information use unless the new purpose is reasonably related to the original one.



3. Acquisition of Personal Information

The Company will acquire personal information in an appropriate and adequate manner only to the extent necessary to achieve the stated purposes.

In addition, when acquiring sensitive personal information (except as permitted under the Personal Information Protection Law), the Company will obtain the individual's prior consent.

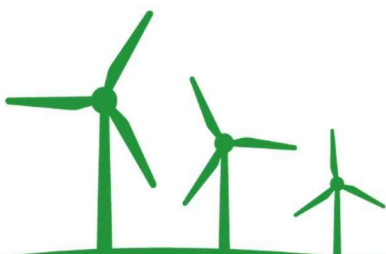
When obtaining information related to personal data from a third party, the Company will obtain the individual's consent.

4. Management of Personal Data

The Company will strive to keep personal data accurate and up to date as needed for its intended purpose, and will delete such data without delay when it is no longer required.

The Company will implement appropriate security measures to prevent the leakage, loss, or damage of personal data.

- (1) To ensure the proper handling of personal data, the Company will formulate and comply with a basic personal information handling policy.
- (2) The Company will establish and adhere to internal rules covering the acquisition, use, storage, and other handling of personal data.
- (3) The Company will assign personnel responsible for managing personal data and will regularly inspect and audit its handling. Results will be reported to the responsible parties, who will evaluate, review, and improve security measures as needed.
- (4) The Company will impose confidentiality obligations on employees and ensure the thorough dissemination of safety protocols and regular training.
- (5) The Company will enforce access controls at offices and implement measures to prevent loss or theft of personal data.
- (6) The Company will limit personal data access by designating specific devices and authorized personnel. Security systems will be introduced to prevent unauthorized access or malware intrusions.
- (7) When handling personal data overseas, the Company will implement appropriate safeguards in accordance with the data protection laws and system of the relevant country.



5. Provision of Personal Information to Third Parties

To achieve the stated purposes, the Company may provide personal information to third parties. Unless required by law, the Company will obtain the individual's consent or take other legally required measures when providing personal information. The Company will not disclose or provide personal information to third parties under any other circumstances.

When providing information related to personal data to third parties, the Company will confirm in advance that the individual's consent has been obtained, as required under the Personal Information Protection Law.

6. Entrustment of Handling Personal Information

To achieve the stated purposes, the Company may outsource the handling of the personal information you provided to a third-party contractor. In such cases, the Company will select an appropriate contractor and supervise them to ensure the safe management of personal information.

7. Sharing of Personal Information

The Company may share personal information for the purposes outlined below.

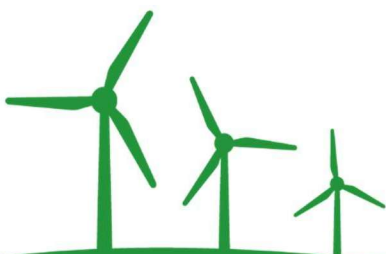
(1) Items of personal data to be shared

Names, contact information (e.g., corporate information, department, title, address, phone number, fax number, email address), as well as details of transactions, feedback, and requests from landowners, clients and business partners, officers, staff and employees, and outsourcing contractors.

(2) Scope of joint users

Corporations and associations established or to be established in the future by the Company; funding partners for those entities; NTT Anode Energy Corporation, JERA Co., Inc., and their group companies, including affiliates and related organizations.

When providing personal information to corporations or organizations in foreign countries, the Company will ensure compliance with applicable laws and regulations.
